10 "28. (a) This appropriation to the department of health is for
11 the purpose of establishing a grant program for emergency medical
12 service providers and county and municipal law enforcement
13 agencies to deliver and improve access to mental health services
14 for first responders as defined by W.S. 27-14-102(a)(xxxi) and law
15 enforcement officers. An emergency medical service provider or
16 county or municipal law enforcement agency seeking a grant under
17 this footnote shall apply to the department detailing the
18 provider's or agency's grant proposal on an application provided
19 by the department. Grant proposals shall be evaluated by the
20 department and prioritized for grant funding based on the following
21 criteria:

23 (i) The degree to which the proposal will reasonably
24 achieve the intent of this program;

26 (ii) The adequacy of the proposal's approach to
27 ensuring that any mental health programming funded through the
28 receipt of a grant can be independently sustained by the emergency
29 medical service provider or county or municipal law enforcement
30 agency into the future."
