FISCAL NOTE

This bill contains an appropriation of \$7,300,000 from the GENERAL FUND.

This bill contains an appropriation of \$62,428,183 from FEDERAL FUNDS. Of this appropriation, \$10,278,183 is effective immediately.

This bill contains an appropriation of \$4,635,000 from SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS.

This bill contains an appropriation of \$30,930,374 from PRIVATE FUNDS.

This bill contains an appropriation of \$131,738,825 from the STRATEGIC INVESTMENTS AND PROJECTS ACCOUNT.

This bill contains an appropriation of \$12,402,574 from the AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT.

This bill provides that any unexpended, unobligated amounts in the CAPITOL BUILDING REHABILITATION AND RESTORATION ACCOUNT, created by W.S. 9-5-109 (j), be transferred to the CAPITOL SQUARE PRESERVATION ACCOUNT, created by W.S. 9-4-225, at the end of each fiscal year. Any unappropriated amounts in the CAPITOL BUILDING REHABILITATION AND RESTORATION ACCOUNT, created by W.S. 9-5-109 (j), are transferred to the CAPITOL SQUARE PRESERVATION ACCOUNT, created by W.S. 9-4-225, on June 30,2022. This transfer is effective immediately.

This bill provides that funds within the CAPITOL SQUARE PRESERVATION ACCOUNT, created by W.S. 9-4-225, are continuously appropriated for maintenance, preservation and enhancement of the capitol building and grounds, the extension from the capitol building to and under the Herschler building and the Herschler building.
