W.S. 19-7-402(a)(intro), (i), (iii), (iv), 8 by creating a new paragraph (v) and (b) is amended to read: 9 10 19-7-402. Wyoming military assistance trust fund; uses of trust fund; administration; rulemaking. 11 12 13 (a) The investment income from the military 14 assistance trust fund created by W.S. 19-7-401 shall be

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1 administered by the adjutant general only to alleviate 2 financial hardships faced by <u>any of the following</u>: 3 4 (i) Any member of the Wyoming national guard or

5 a <u>military</u> reserve unit that is based in Wyoming who has 6 been called to active duty or active state service;

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8 (iii) Any other Wyoming resident performing 9 service in the uniformed services as defined in W.S. 10 19-11-103(a)(ix) for any branch of the military of the 11 United States; and

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(iv) Members of the immediate family of those 13 personnel identified in paragraphs (i) through (iii) of 14 15 this subsection. For purposes of this paragraph subsection, 16 "immediate family" means spouse and each child as defined 17 by W.S. 2-1-301(a)(v) and, if they are dependents of the 18 of the military, the parents, grandparents, member 19 siblings, stepchildren and adult children of the member of 20 the military;-

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1	responsibilities directly related to their service in the
2	Wyoming National Guard to enable participation without

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6	(b) The <del>interest income earned <u>earnings</u> from the</del>
7	military assistance trust fund shall only be used as a last
8	resort to assist eligible military personnel and families
9	deal with financial hardship resulting from the military
10	member's active duty status or other required military duty
11	and shall not be used to supplant any other private or
12	public funds to the extent such funds are available.
