This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other 14 15 purpose. 16 17 (b) The task force members shall include two (2) members of 18 the house of representatives selected by the speaker of the house, two (2) members of the senate selected by the president of the 19 20 senate, the director of the Wyoming community development authority or the director's designee and three (3) non-legislative 21 22 members of the public who have experience in housing issues to be 23 appointed by the governor.
