1 2 (iii) "Large project" means a project for which 3 the total of all grants sought or previously awarded under 4 this act equals or exceeds two hundred thousand dollars 5 (\$200,000.00) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00); 6 7 (vi) "Small project" means a project for which the total of all grants sought or previously awarded under 8 9 this act is less than two hundred thousand dollars 10 (\$200,000.00) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00); 11 9-15-104. Wildlife and natural resource trust account 12 13 board established; terms; meetings; duties. 14 (k) No funds shall initially be expended from the 15 16 income account for large projects except upon specific legislative authorization. Following the 17 initial legislative authorization to expend funds for a large 18 19 project, the board may approve additional grants for that 20 large project not to exceed a total of an additional one 21 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) two hundred thousand 22 dollars (\$200,000.00) and shall forward a notice of any
