AN ACT relating to economic development; authorizing the use of broadband development subaccount funds as matching grant funds and for administrative expenses as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 9-12-1404(a)(ii) is amended to read:

9-12-1404. Economic diversification account created; authorized expenditures.

There is created an economic diversification (a) account. All monies in the account are continuously appropriated to the office of the governor to be used for the purposes of this article and as otherwise specified by law, including per diem, mileage and other administrative expenses of the ENDOW executive council. Notwithstanding 9-2-1008 and 9-4-207, funds W.S. in the account or subaccounts of the account shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal period. Interest earned on funds in the account shall deposited to the account be or appropriate subaccount. Within the account shall be subaccounts. For accounting and investment purposes only all subaccounts shall be treated as separate accounts. The subaccounts are as follows:

(ii) The broadband development subaccount. Funds within this subaccount may be expended as requested by the Wyoming business council and approved by the governor or his designee to:

(A) Provide funding for agreements entered into pursuant to W.S. 9-12-1501 through 9-12-1510;

(B) Provide the state's share of any matching funds required for the state to receive federal funds under any federal broadband program including, but not limited to, the broadband equity, access and deployment program established by the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, P.L. 117-58; 135 Stat. 429;

(C) Pay the reasonable administrative expenses of the Wyoming business council in an amount not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00). ORIGINAL HOUSE BILL NO. HB0071
