1 AN ACT relating to school building and facility projects;
 2 providing for supplemental appropriations for the period
 3 commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026;
 4 specifying conditions for expenditures; reappropriating
 5 funds; and providing for an effective date.

1 expenditure of appropriated funds, subject to
 2 restrictions contained in W.S. 21-15-119(c). The
 3 estimated schedule shall be based upon
 4 information, processes, events and expenditures
 5 and shall not be binding upon the state
 6 construction department or the school facilities
 7 commission.

9 (\$9,891,246.00). Any disposition or demolition of
10 buildings or facilities shall be subject to
11 commission approval and included in the
12 district's facility plan to ensure the
13 disposition or demolition protects the financial
14 interest of the state and is in the public
15 interest as required under W.S. 21-15-123(f)(vi);

17 (xii) For unanticipated costs
18 associated with the projects funded under
19 paragraphs (j)(iii) through (xi) of this

3 (k) Notwithstanding any other provision of
4 law, of the unexpended, obligated monies
5 appropriated from the school capital construction
6 account to the school facilities commission under
7 2023 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 94, Section
8 313(j)(xiii), up to thirteen million four hundred
9 thousand dollars (\$13,400,000.00), or as much
10 thereof as is available, shall not revert upon
11 completion of the projects pursuant to 2023
12 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 94, Section 313(d),
13 and are hereby reappropriated to the school
14 facilities commission to supplement previous
15 appropriations for inflationary costs associated
16 with projects approved by the commission and
17 funded by the legislature. The original scope and
18 design of the projects for which these funds are
19 expended shall not be modified as a result of the
20 expenditure of the funds reappropriated under
21 this subsection. This reappropriation shall not
22 be transferred or expended for any other purpose.
23 The commission shall report the expenditure of

1 funds reappropriated under this subsection as
2 required under subsection (h) of this section.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become a law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
