## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; providing 1 for the certification of water well drilling contractors 2 3 and water well pump installation contractors; providing 4 definitions; creating a board of examining water well 5 drilling contractors and water well pump installation 6 contractors; providing duties and powers of the board; 7 establishing certification procedures; providing for fees; providing for examinations and continuing education; 8 9 providing for landowner exemptions as specified; providing 10 for revocation or suspension of certificate; granting 11 rulemaking authority; providing penalties; and providing 12 for an effective date.

8	33-42-101. Short title.									
9										
10	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Water Well									
11	Drilling Contractors and Water Well Pump Installation									
12	Contractors Act."									
13										
14	33-42-102. Definitions.									
15										
16	(a) As used in this act:									
17										
18	(i) "Board" means the state board of examining									
19	water well drilling contractors and water well pump									
20	installation contractors;									
21										
22	(ii) "Underground water" means any water,									
23	including hot water and geothermal steam, under the surface									

1 of the land or under the bed of any stream, lake or

2 reservoir;

3

4 (iii) "Water well drilling contractor" means any

5 person responsible for or causing the construction,

equipping, test pumping or development of any water well 6

7 for compensation or otherwise as provided by this act;

8

9 (iv) "Water well pump installation contractor"

means any person who is in the business of installing 10

pumping equipment in water wells for compensation or 11

12 otherwise as provided by this act;

13

14 (v) "Well" means any artificial opening in the

15 ground for the production of groundwater or the disposal of

water underground, including developed springs, test wells, 16

17 monitoring wells, deep well ground beds (cathodic

protection bores), geothermal or heat exchange wells, drive 18

points and excavations for the purpose of artificial 19

20 recharge to the groundwater bodies or disposal of wastes.

21 The term "well" does not include excavations made for the

22 dewatering of construction sites, mines or oil and gas

wells, and the prospecting for and removal of mineral 23

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1 products, nor wells for the production of the media for

2 secondary oil recovery;

4 (vi) "This act" means W.S. 33-42-101 through

5 33-42-112.

6

7 33-42-103. Certification.

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9 It is unlawful for any person to use in connection with his

10 name or to advertise any title or description tending to

11 convey the impression that he is a certified water well

12 drilling contractor or water well pump installation

13 contractor unless he has been certified under this act.

14

15 33-42-104. Board of examining water well drilling

16 contractors and water well pump installation contractors

17 created; composition; appointment; terms; vacancies;

18 qualification; compensation.

19

20 (a) The state board of examining water well drilling

21 contractors and water well pump installation contractors is

22 created to consist of the following seven (7) members:

(i) The state engineer or 1 his authorized 2 representative; 3 director of 4 (ii) The the department 5 environmental quality or his authorized representative; and 6 7 (iii) Five (5) members appointed by the governor as follows: 8 9 10 (A) One (1) water well drilling contractor engaged in the practice of irrigation well contracting or a 11 municipal or industrial well contractor; 12 13 14 (B) One (1) water well drilling contractor 15 engaged in the practice of domestic and stock water well 16 contracting; 17 18 (C) One (1) at large water well drilling 19 contractor; 20 21 (D) One (1) water well pump installation 22 contractor; and 23

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1 (E) One (1) member of the general public

2 who owns an active water well.

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4 (b) The members appointed by the governor shall serve

5 for a term of four (4) years, except three (3) of the

initial appointments shall be for a term of two (2) 6

years. Each member shall hold office until his successor 7

is appointed and has been qualified. The governor may 8

9 remove any member of the board as provided by W.S. 9-1-202.

10 A vacancy occurring in the board by death, resignation or

11 otherwise, shall be filled by appointment by the governor

12 upon recommendation of the remaining board members for the

13 unexpired term.

14

(c) Each member of the board appointed by the 15

governor shall have been a resident of this state for at 16

17 least one (1) year at the time of his appointment. Each

contractor board member shall have been engaged in the 18

practice of his profession for at least five (5) years 19

20 prior to his appointment. After the appointment of the

21 initial board, any water well drilling contractor or water

22 well pump installation contractor appointed to the board

shall be certified within six (6) months after appointment. 23

1 (	d)	The	members	of	the	board	shall	serve	without

compensation other than per diem and mileage allowance as 2

3 allowed to state employees for the performance of their

4 duties.

5

33-42-105. Organization of board; meetings; quorum; 6

7 disposition of funds.

8

9 The state engineer or his representative shall be (a)

10 secretary of the board and shall have charge of the records

11 and be responsible for budget preparation and general

12 administrative duties.

13

14 (b) The members of the board shall elect a chairman

from their membership who shall hold office for a term of 15

two (2) years. No member shall serve more than two (2) 16

17 consecutive terms as chairman.

18

(c) Meetings of the board shall be called by the 19

20 chairman or upon request of not less than four (4) members

21 and held in an appropriate location. The board shall hold

22 not less than two (2) meetings each year. Four (4) members

23 shall constitute a quorum. No decision shall be made

1 unless it receives the affirmative votes of at least four

2 (4) members of the board.

3

4 (d) Fees collected by the board shall be paid into

5 the state treasury and credited to an account which shall

be used by the board to defray costs incurred in the 6

7 administration of this act. The board shall not maintain

unnecessary fund balances. 8

9

10 33-42-106. Powers of the board in general; enjoining

11 unlawful acts.

12

13 The board is entitled to the services of the (a)

14 attorney general in the conduct of its affairs and shall

15 reimburse the attorney general for actual cost of legal

16 services provided.

17

(b) Whenever any person has engaged or is about to 18

19 engage in any acts or practices which constitute a

20 violation of this act, the board, or the attorney general

21 on its behalf, may make application to the appropriate

22 court for an order enjoining those acts. Upon a showing by

23 the board that the person has engaged or is about to engage

24 in any illegal act, an injunction, restraining order or

- 1 other appropriate order shall be granted by the court
- 2 without bond, and without the necessity of a showing of
- 3 actual damages by the board.

- 5 (c) The board may compel the attendance of witnesses,
- administer oaths and take testimony concerning all matters 6
- 7 within its jurisdiction.

8

33-42-107. Duties of the board. 9

10

(a) The board shall: 11

12

- 13 (i) Supervise the general administration of this
- 14 act;

15

- 16 (ii) Enforce the provisions of this act and any
- 17 rules and regulations promulgated under it and take all
- action necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; 18

19

- 20 (iii) Examine the qualifications of anyone
- 21 desiring to obtain a certification to engage in the
- 22 business of water well drilling or the business of water
- well pump installing within the state; 23

1 (iv) Adopt rules and regulations necessary to

2 carry out the provisions of this act;

3

4 (v) Conduct hearings upon complaints with

5 respect to any person certified under this act in

conformity with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure 6

7 Act. The hearing shall be held in the county where the

complaint originated; and 8

9

(vi) Establish continuing education for persons 10

11 certified to maintain knowledge of current industry

12 standards. However, the board shall not impose continuing

education requirements for any person which exceed eighteen 13

(18) hours in any three (3) year period. 14

15

16 33-42-108. Certification in general; qualifications

17 applicant; operator's certificate; temporary

18 certificate.

19

20 The board shall issue a certificate to (a) an

21 applicant who:

22

23 (i) Is eighteen (18) years of age or older;

24

1 (ii) Has demonstrated professional competence by

2 passing an examination prescribed by the board;

3

4 (iii) Has paid the required fee; and

5

6 (iv) Has provided written documentation of

7 financial responsibility, including proof of general

8 liability insurance.

9

10 (b) In the case of hardship, the board may provide

11 special arrangements for administering the examination

12 required by this act.

13

14 (c) The state engineer may, if the applicant meets

15 all other requirements, issue a temporary certificate until

16 the next examination by the board. The temporary

17 certificate shall not be renewed more than once for any

18 applicant.

19

20 (d) An applicant for a certificate to engage in the

21 business of water well drilling or the business of water

22 well pump installing who is currently licensed or certified

23 in another state whose licensure or certification

24 requirements meets or exceeds the requirements of this

- 1 state, may receive a certificate by endorsement without
- 2 examination in this state upon submitting an application to
- 3 the board together with a certification from the board or
- 4 licensing or certifying agency of the state in which the
- 5 applicant is licensed or certified and payment of the
- required fee. 6

- (e) Subsection (d) of this section shall apply only 8
- 9 if the state in which the applicant is currently licensed
- 10 or certified grants similar reciprocity to persons
- 11 certified in Wyoming.

12

13 33-42-109. Fees; renewal of lapsed certificates.

14

- (a) The board shall establish reasonable and 15
- 16 necessary fees pursuant to W.S. 33-1-201 for:

17

- (i) Examination and reexamination 18 of
- 19 certification applicants;

- 21 (ii) Certification fees shall not exceed two
- 22 hundred dollars (\$200.00). Renewal fees shall not exceed
- two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for a three (3) year period 23
- 24 thereafter.

2 33-42-110. Examination; notification; reexamination.

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3

4 (a) An examination shall be given at least twice

5 annually. The examination shall be given at a location

6 designated by the board.

7

8 (b) The examination shall consist of a written or

9 oral examination testing the applicant's knowledge of the

10 basics of construction and state law, rules, regulations

11 and local ordinances concerning the construction of water

12 wells or installation of water well pumps and pumping

13 equipment.

14

15 (c) Not less than thirty (30) days prior to

16 examination the board shall notify each applicant that his

17 application and evidence submitted for certification is

18 satisfactory and accepted or unsatisfactory and rejected.

19 If rejected, the reasons for rejection shall be given. The

20 notice shall include the date and location of the

21 examination.

- (d) In the event an applicant fails to receive a 1
- 2 passing grade on examination, he may reapply for
- 3 examination within ninety (90) days.

- 33-42-111. Denial, revocation or suspension 5 of
- 6 certificate; hearing.

7

- (a) The board may withhold, deny, revoke or suspend 8
- 9 any certificate issued or applied for in accordance with
- the provisions of this act upon proof that the certificate 10
- holder or applicant: 11

12

- 13 (i) Has used fraud or deception in applying for
- a certificate or in the taking of the examination; 14

15

- (ii) Has willfully or negligently violated any 16
- of the provisions of this act, the rules and regulations 17
- adopted pursuant to this act or the statutes or rules and 18
- regulations of the state pertaining to underground water; 19
- 20 or

21

- 22 (iii) Has failed while engaging in the business
- of water well construction contracting or water well pump 23

installation contracting to comply with the state water 1

2 well minimum construction standards.

3

4 (b) No certificate may be suspended or revoked unless

5 there has been a hearing in conformity with the provisions

of the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act. 6

7

8 33-42-112. Violation and penalties.

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10 After two (2) years from the effective date of this act,

violation of any of the provisions of this act is a 11

12 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not to exceed seven

hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), a sentence of not to 13

exceed six (6) months in jail, or both. 14

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16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
