1 (i) Anywhere within the corporate limits of the 2 municipality in which the officer is employed; 3 4 (ii) Outside the corporate limits of the 5 municipality in which the officer is employed when on property owned by or under the control of the municipality; 6 7 and 8 9 (iii) Outside the corporate limits of the 10 municipality in which the peace officer is employed, when 11 in fresh pursuit of an individual. For purposes of this 12 paragraph, "fresh pursuit" means pursuit without 13 unnecessary delay and initiated within the corporate limits of the municipality for violation of a municipal ordinance 14 or state law committed in view of the peace officer. 15 16 Section 2. The common law doctrine of fresh pursuit 17 is intended to continue as it existed prior to the 18 19 effective date of this act, except as specifically modified 20 by this act. 21 22 Section 3.
