1 (i) Sell, barter, exchange, deliver or otherwise 2 permit to be delivered the liquefied petroleum gas 3 container;

5 (ii) Dismantle, evacuate, service, install, fill, refill, tamper with or otherwise use in any manner 6 7 the liquefied petroleum gas container; or

9 (iii) Deface, erase, obliterate, remove, 10 conceal, cover up or otherwise change any part of the 11 container bearing the name or other identification of the 12 lawful owner of the container or the manufacturer's 13 specifications concerning the container.

15 (b) This section shall not apply to portable 16 containers constructed in compliance with federal regulations that have less than two hundred thirty-nine 17 (239) pounds of water capacity and that are capable of 18 storing liquefied petroleum gas. 19

21 (c) A violation of subsection (a) of this section is 22 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty 23 dollars (\$750.00), or both. 24
