

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0203

Retired judges compensation.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judges; amending the compensation paid  
2 to retired judges who serve under assignment as specified;  
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-106(f) is amended to read:

9 **5-1-106. Retirement of judges of the supreme court or**  
10 **district courts; pension; assignment of retired judges.**

12 (f) Any justice of the supreme court or district  
13 court judge of this state, who has retired ~~pursuant to the~~  
14 ~~provisions of this section~~ from full-time service, and who  
15 is not practicing law, may, notwithstanding such  
16 retirement, be called upon, with his consent, at the

1 request of a district court judge, with the consent of the  
2 chief justice, or by the chief justice, and assigned to  
3 service on any court. A retired justice or judge shall  
4 receive as a salary during any period of assignment, ~~the~~  
5 ~~difference between his retirement allowance as provided by~~  
6 ~~law and the current compensation of a judge of the court to~~  
7 ~~which he is assigned~~ an hourly rate calculated by dividing  
8 the salary provided in W.S. 5-1-110 for the court to which  
9 the retired justice or judge is assigned by forty-nine (49)  
10 weeks and dividing the result by forty (40) hours. When  
11 called to serve, a retired judge or justice shall receive  
12 the same per diem and travel allowances as allowed active  
13 judges or justices. Per diem, allowances and compensation  
14 shall be paid from the contingent fund of the court to  
15 which such judge or justice is assigned.

17 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
20 Constitution.
