7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-508 is created to read:

- 11 6-2-508. Assault by contamination; aggravated assault
- 12 by contamination; penalties.

14 (a) As used in this section:

15

1 (i) "Bodily tissues, fluids or wastes" means

2 substances or secretions from the human body, including but

3 not limited to, skin, flesh, blood, saliva, urine and

4 feces;

6 (ii) "Peace officer" means as defined by W.S.

7 - 2 - 101(a)(iv);

8

9 (iii) "Probation officer" means a state, county,

10 municipal or other court-appointed official or employee

11 assigned and trained in the performance of probation

12 supervision services;

13

14 (iv) "Serious contagious or infectious disease"

15 means any disease or contagion that bears a substantial

16 probability of death or grave physical or mental injury or

17 debilitation for any person who comes into contact with or

18 contracts the disease or contagion, including but not

19 limited to, Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and

20 Hepatitis.

22 (b) A person is guilty of assault by contamination if

23 he purposefully or knowingly causes one (1) or more of his

24 bodily tissues, fluids or wastes to make physical contact

- 1 with, or be introduced into the food or drink of, a peace
- 2 officer, probation officer, or an inmate, staff member or
- 3 authorized visitor of a state, county or municipal
- 4 correctional facility or work release center.

- 6 (c) A person is guilty of aggravated assault by
- 7 contamination if, at the time of the assault, the person
- 8 knows he has a serious contagious or infectious disease and
- 9 purposefully or knowingly causes one (1) or more of his
- 10 bodily tissues, fluids or wastes to make physical contact
- 11 with, or be introduced into the food or drink of, a peace
- 12 officer, probation officer, or an inmate, staff member or
- 13 authorized visitor of a state, county or municipal
- 14 correctional facility or work release center.

- 16 (d) Assault by contamination is a misdemeanor
- 17 punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6)
- 18 months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars
- 19 (\$750.00), or both. Aggravated assault by contamination is
- 20 a felony punishable by not more than ten (10) years
- 21 imprisonment. Any sentence imposed upon conviction
- 22 pursuant to this subsection shall be served consecutively
- 23 to any sentence currently being served.
