A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the dissolution of marriage; making  
2 financial information provided by parties for child support  
3 confidential; removing parties' social security numbers  
4 from divorce decrees; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 20-2-308 by creating a new subsection  
9 (d) and 20-2-309 (a) (intro) and (i) are amended to read:

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11 **20-2-308. Financial affidavits required; financial**  
12 **reporting.**

14 (d) All financial affidavits and records required by  
15 law to be attached to the affidavit shall constitute a  
16 confidential file and are subject to inspection by persons

1 other than the parties, their attorneys or the department  
2 of family services to the extent necessary to enforce the  
3 Child Support Enforcement Act and the Uniform Interstate  
4 Family Support Act only by court order.

6 **20-2-309. Contents of orders; change of address or**  
7 **employment; income withholding entered; payment.**

8

9 (a) All orders shall include the ~~social security~~  
10 ~~numbers,~~ dates of birth and places of births of the  
11 parties. Any decree which includes an order providing for  
12 child support shall ~~also provide for a~~ be accompanied by a  
13 separate statement ~~of the~~ that shall remain confidential  
14 and subject to inspection by persons other than the  
15 parties, their attorneys or the department of family  
16 services to the extent necessary to enforce the Child  
17 Support Enforcement Act and the Uniform Interstate Family  
18 Support Act only by court order and contains the:

20 (i) Addresses and social security numbers of the  
21 parties;

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2       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
