FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to civil actions; amending the immunity of persons and organizations operating ambulance and rescue vehicles as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 1-1-120(b) is amended to read:

1-1-120. Persons rendering emergency assistance exempt from civil liability.

Persons or organizations operating volunteer ambulances or rescue vehicles supported by public private funds, staffed by unpaid volunteers, and which make no charge, or charge an incidental service or user fee, for services rendered during medical emergencies, and the unpaid volunteers who staff ambulances and rescue vehicles are not liable for any civil damages for acts or omissions in good faith in furnishing emergency medical services. immunity does not apply to acts or omissions constituting gross negligence or willful or For purposes of this section, "unpaid misconduct. volunteers" means persons who either receive incidental remuneration on a per call basis or receive no more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) annually for volunteer ambulance and rescue activities. If an unpaid volunteer's acts or omissions are subject to the provisions of the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act, immunity under this section is waived to the extent of the maximum liability provided under W.S. 1-39-118.

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Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
