FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING  
2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to motor vehicle safety restraints; modifying requirements for usage of child safety restraint systems for specified age levels; eliminating superfluous definitions; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-1303(a) is amended to read:

**31-5-1303. Child safety restraint system; required use; exception.**

(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that vehicle and who is ~~four (4)~~ eight (8) years of age or under, and who weighs ~~forty (40)~~ eighty (80) pounds or less, is properly secured in a child safety restraint system in a seat of the vehicle other than the front seat, except if the vehicle is only equipped with one (1) row of seats, the child may be properly secured in a child safety restraint system in the front passenger seat of the vehicle.
