2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to child care services; excluding child care employees paid or subsidized by the department of family services from coverage under the workers' compensation program; amending a definition; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 27-14-102(a)(vii) by creating a new subparagraph (Q) is amended to read:

**27-14-102. Definitions.**

(a) As used in this act:

(vii) "Employee" means any person engaged in any extrahazardous employment under any appointment, contract of hire or apprenticeship, express or implied, oral or written, and includes legally employed minors and aliens authorized to work by the United States department of justice, immigration and naturalization service. "Employee" does not include:

(Q) An individual providing child day care or babysitting services, whose wages are subsidized or paid in whole or in part by the Wyoming department of family services. This exclusion from coverage does not exclude from coverage an individual providing child day care or babysitting services as an employee of any individual or entity other than the Wyoming department of family services.
