2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to therapeutic foster care homes; exempting foster care homes from requirements under the workers' compensation program; amending a definition; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 27-14-102(a)(vii) by creating a new subparagraph (Q) is amended to read:

27-14-102. Definitions.

(a) As used in this act:

(vii) "Employee" means any person engaged in any extrahazardous employment under any appointment, contract of hire or apprenticeship, express or implied, oral or written, and includes legally employed minors and aliens authorized to work by the United States department of justice, immigration and naturalization service. "Employee" does not include:

(Q) A foster parent providing foster care services for the department of family services or for a certified child placement agency.
