FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING
2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to small employer health insurance availability; modifying index rate variations within a business class as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 26-19-304(a)(ii) is amended to read:

26-19-304. Restrictions relating to premium rates.

(a) Premium rates for health benefit plans subject to this act shall be subject to the following provisions:

(ii) For a class of business, the premium rates charged during a rating period to small employers with similar case characteristics for the same or similar coverage, or the rates which could be charged to ~~such~~ employers under the rating system for that class of business shall not vary from the index rate by more than ~~twenty-five percent (25%)~~ thirty-five (35%) of the index rate;
