1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; modifying various 2 license, application and other fees for hunting, fishing, 3 trapping and associated activities; modifying landowner coupon fee; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. W.S. 23-2-101(e), (j)(i) through (v), 8 9 (viii), (ix), (xi) through (xiv), (xvii), (xviii), (xxi) 10 through (xxvi), (xxix), (xxx), (xxxiii) through (xxxv) and (xxxvii) through (xli), 23-2-107(e), 23-2-201(d)(i) and 11 (ii), 23-2-301(c)(i), (iii) through (ix), (xi) and (xii) 12 13 and 23-3-105(b) are amended to read:

15 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application 16 fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency 17 required.

2 (e) Resident and nonresident license applicants shall 3 pay an application fee in an amount specified by this 4 subsection upon submission of an application for purchase 5 of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license or wild bison license. The resident application fee shall 6 be three dollars (\$3.00) four dollars (\$4.00) and the 7 nonresident application fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) 8 9 twelve dollars (\$12.00). The application fee is in addition 10 to the fees prescribed by subsections (f) and (j) of this 11 section and by W.S. 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the 12 department either directly or through an authorized selling 13 agent of the department. At the beginning of each month, the commission shall set aside all of the fees collected 14 during calendar year 1980 and not to exceed twenty-five 15 16 percent (25%) of the fees collected thereafter pursuant to 17 this subsection to establish and maintain a working balance five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), to 18 of 19 compensate owners or lessees of property damaged by game 20 animals and game birds.

22	detached, dated, signed and delivered to the landowner. The
23	landowner on or before February 1 following the year for
24	which the license was valid, shall deliver to the

1 department the coupon and an affidavit that the antelope, 2 deer or elk for which the coupon was delivered was killed 3 on his land. Upon receipt of the coupon and affidavit the 4 department shall pay the landowner eleven dollars (\$11.00) 5 thirteen dollars (\$13.00) for each coupon from an antelope, elk license. Landowner's 6 deer or coupons are not transferable. Any unauthorized person attempting to collect 7 any sum for any landowner's coupon is guilty of a second 8 9 degree misdemeanor. Effective January 1, 2000 through 10 December 31, 2004, the department shall provide a checkoff 11 box on each landowner coupon affidavit claim form that 12 offers the claimant the opportunity to designate the animal 13 damage management board to receive his payment amount for landowner coupons claimed on that form. For each claim made 14 where the landowner has designated their payment to the 15 16 animal damage management board, the department shall 17 transfer that amount to the animal damage management account created by W.S. 11-6-306 and the department shall 18 retain such fees related to those administrative costs of 19 20 the transfer. 21
