## A BILL

## for

1	AN ACT relating to the state employees and officials group
2	insurance plan; providing a state contribution for
3	retirees; and providing for an effective date.

5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7	Section 1. W.S. 9-3-210(a) through (c) is amended to
8	read:

10	9-3-210. Amount of state's contribution; estimates
11	submitted to state budget officer; specified employees
12	participation in federal program.
13	
14	(a) The state shall contribute monthly the amount
15	established and appropriated by the legislature for each

1	employee and official enrolled in the plan in accordance
2	with subsections (b) and (c) of this section. For retirees,
3	the state shall contribute for each retiree enrolled in the
4	plan, the lesser of:
5	
6	(i) Three hundred dollars (\$300.00); or
7	
8	(ii) The premium for coverage of the retiree
9	under the plan.
10	
11	(b) Any state agency, department or institution,
12	including the University of Wyoming and the community
13	colleges in the state, shall pay monthly to the department
14	the amount established and appropriated by the legislature
15	for each eligible employee or official electing to become
16	covered by any portion of the group insurance plan as the
17	contribution of the state to that plan during the period
18	the employee or official is enrolled in the plan. If the
19	monthly premium for coverage of the employee or official is
20	less than the amount established and appropriated by the
21	legislature, the balance may be applied to the premium for
22	coverage of dependents, or to the premium for any optional
23	group insurance coverage made available by the department,
24	if so elected. <u>The department shall receive all</u>

1	appropriations for retiree contributions under subsection
2	(a) of this section and shall apply monthly the amount
3	established under subsection (a) of this section for each
4	eligible retiree electing to become covered by any portion
5	of the group insurance plan as the contribution of the
6	retiree to that plan during the period the retiree is
7	enrolled in the plan.
8	
9	(c) Each state agency, department or institution,
10	including the University of Wyoming and the community
11	colleges in the state shall estimate the amount required
12	for its participation in the group insurance plan for the
13	next biennium and shall submit the estimate to the state
14	budget officer at the time the state budget officer makes
15	the request. The board shall estimate the amount required
16	for retiree contributions under subsection (a) of this
17	section and shall submit the estimate as provided by this
