9	Section 1. W.S. $24-9-101(a)(v)$ and (b) is amended to

13	viewers and appraisers; bond; rules.

15	(a) Any person whose land has no outlet to, nor							
16	connection with a public road, may file an application in							
17	writing with the board of county commissioners in the

1 county where his land is located for a private road leading 2 from his land to some convenient public road. The 3 application shall contain the following information:

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5 (v) The legal description and the names and addresses of the affected parties of all land, including 6 7 both surface and subsurface interests, over which any proposed access routes would cross. Affected parties 8 includes the owners of record, holders of recorded 9 10 easements and rights of way and any lessee, mortgagee or 11 occupant of the surface or subsurface of the land over 12 which any proposed road would cross and may include the 13 state of Wyoming; and

15 (b) Within ten (10) days after filing an application with the board, the applicant shall give notice in writing 16 17 by certified mail, with return receipt, to the affected parties of all lands, including both surface and subsurface 18 19 interests, over which any private road is applied for, of 20 his pending application for a private road. The notice 21 shall include a complete copy of the original application 22 and any amendments thereto.
