6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-14-205(c) is amended to read:

9

10 **39-14-205**. Exemptions.

11

- 12 (c) Tertiary production resulting from projects
- 13 certified by the Wyoming oil and gas conservation
- 14 commission after July 1, 1985 March 31, 2003, and before
- 15 March 31, 2001 2008, is exempt from the severance taxes
- imposed by W.S. 39-14-204 (a) (iii) for a period of five (5)
- 17 years from date of first tertiary production. A taxpayer

1 claiming a tax reduction under this subsection is

2 prohibited from claiming a tax reduction provided by

3 subsection (f) or (g) of this section.

4

5 **Section 2.** The oil and gas conservation commission

6 and the department of revenue shall on or before December 1

7 of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007 jointly report to the

8 joint revenue interim committee of the legislature

9 concerning tertiary production qualifying for the exemption

10 provided in W.S. 39-14-205(c). The report shall include

11 the amount of production, operators, number of wells,

12 amount of severance taxes paid on that production, amount

of severance taxes exempted under W.S. 39-14-205(c), and ad

14 valorem and sales taxes paid in connection with that

15 production.

17 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

20 Constitution.
