1 (iv) The person's social security number, 2 temporary identification number issued by the Internal 3 Revenue Service for a person who does not qualify for a 4 social security number or other numbers or letters deemed 5 appropriate on applications for instruction permits, driver's licenses, commercial driver's 6 licenses and 7 commercial driver instruction permits; 8 9 31-7-115. Issuance, description and contents. 10 (a) Upon the satisfactory completion of any required 11 examination, the division shall issue to every qualifying 12 13 applicant a driver's license, and: 14 15 (iii) The driver's license shall include, but not be limited to, the following information: 16 17 18 (C) The full legal name, any identifying 19 numbers or letters deemed appropriate, date of birth, 20 mailing address, height, weight and sex of the licensee. 21 Unless otherwise required by federal law, neither the 22 social security number nor temporary identification number issued by the Internal Revenue Service, of the person shall 23
