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- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-4-102, 18-3-102(a) by creating a
- 12 new paragraph (viii) and 18-3-103(a)(intro) and by

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13 creating a new paragraph (iv) are amended to read:

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15 **7-4-102.** Deputy coroners.

- 1 The county coroner, with the consent of the board of county
- 2 commissioners, may appoint deputy coroners, who shall serve
- 3 in the absence or inability of the coroner and who shall
- 4 receive the same compensation as provided in W.S. 7-4-210
- 5 for the county coroner the board of county commissioners
- 6 determines by resolution.

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- 8 18-3-102. County officers required to execute bonds;
- 9 amount; sureties; penalty.

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- 11 (a) All county officers, except county attorneys,
- 12 before assuming the duties of their office and within
- 13 twenty (20) days after the commencement of the term for
- 14 which they were elected or appointed, shall take, subscribe
- 15 and file the oath of office, and execute and file their
- 16 official bonds to the state of Wyoming to insure the honest
- 17 and faithful performance of their duties, in the penal
- 18 amounts specified and according to the following
- 19 provisions:

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- 21 (viii) County coroner: a bond as specified in
- 22 W.S. 7-4-101.

If the county does not provide an office then the office shall be maintained at a place 10 11 directed approved by the board of county commissioners: 12 13 (iv) The office of the county coroner may be 14 located at any suitable location determined by the county 15 coroner with the approval of the board of county 16 commissioners. 17 18 Section 2.
