Wyoming veterans' affairs commission.

A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming veterans' affairs
- 2 commission; amending the name of the commission to the
- 3 Wyoming veterans' commission; conforming the name of the
- 4 veterans' affairs commission expendable trust fund;
- 5 conforming other provisions; and providing for an effective
- 6 date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-14-107(a), 19-14-108(a),
- 31-2-204 (b), 31-2-215 (d), 31-2-216 (h) and 31-2-217 (h) are
- 12 amended to read:

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- 14 19-14-107. Creation of veterans' commission;
- 15 composition; terms.

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1 (a) A Wyoming veterans' affairs commission is created 2 within the military department consisting of twelve (12) 3 members, not less than one (1) of whom shall reside in each 4 judicial district identified in W.S. 5-3-101, appointed by 5 the governor for terms of two (2) years. Appointments shall be made without regard to political affiliation, sex, 6 religion or ethnic background. The governor may remove any 7 member as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. A chairman shall be 8 9 elected by the commission from among its members and a new 10 chairman elected every two (2) years thereafter.

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12 **19-14-108**. Veterans' cemetery; acquisition and 13 maintenance; eligibility for burial.

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15 (a) Military department, with the approval of the 16 veterans' affairs commission, may acquire a site in this 17 state to be used to establish a cemetery for the interment of veterans of the United States armed forces and for 18 19 qualified family members of eligible veterans. The approval 20 of the local governing body of the county in which the 21 proposed site is located shall be obtained prior to any 22 acquisition of land for this purpose. The department, with the approval of the commission, is empowered to receive any 23 24 lands granted to the state or any of its political

- 1 subdivisions. All military cemeteries currently owned by
- 2 the state of Wyoming shall be operated and controlled by

3 the military department.

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5 31-2-204. Issuance of certificates of registration

6 and license plates by county; form.

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8 (b) Except as otherwise provided, license plates shall be of metal not less than twelve (12) inches long in 9 10 the left-hand end of which shall be arabic numerals for the 11 county in which issued, followed by the bucking horse and 12 rider emblem and a distinctive number assigned to the vehicle, set forth in numerals and letters as determined by 13 14 the department and above or underneath such numerals shall be the word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the year of 15 16 issue or validation. License plates issued to dealers and 17 for trailers shall contain appropriate identification which may be in lieu of the bucking horse and rider emblem. 18 19 License plates shall be changed or validated annually. 20 There shall be a marked contrast between the color of the 21 plate and that of the numerals and letters and the 22 background of all plates shall be fully reflectorized.

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Motorcycle plates shall not be less than three (3) inches

wide and six (6) inches long. Antique license plates shall

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1 bear no date and shall bear the inscription "Pioneer Wyo". 2 License stickers for trucks and trailers used by any farmer 3 or rancher for the transportation of livestock, feed or unprocessed agricultural products owned and produced by the 4 5 farmer or rancher from the place of production to market and of ranch supplies intended solely for the use of the 6 farmer or rancher, and not for sale, on the return trip, 7 and not for the transportation of goods and persons for 8 9 hire shall bear the inscription "Farm". Upon application to 10 the department and payment of a fee as provided by W.S. 11 31-3-102(a)(xix), veteran license stickers bearing the 12 inscription "Veteran" and designating the conflict service 13 of the veteran may be issued to the veterans' affairs 14 commission in a format approved by the department. The veterans' affairs commission may sell the veteran license 15 16 sticker to qualified veterans at a fee not to exceed cost, 17 plus ten dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle. Any fees collected by the veterans' affairs commission under this subsection 18 shall be deposited in the veterans' affairs commission 19 20 expendable trust fund. The veterans' affairs commission 21 shall establish eligibility criteria for veterans applying 22 for a veteran license sticker. A qualified veteran 23 purchasing a veteran license sticker manufactured by the 24 department and sold by the veterans' affairs commission may

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- 1 display the sticker on the license plate issued by the
- 2 county treasurer. The provisions of W.S. 31-2-205(a)(iv)
- 3 shall not apply to any veteran license sticker manufactured
- 4 by the department and displayed as provided in this

5 section.

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7 31-2-215. Disabled veteran's license plates.

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- 9 (d) A veteran who qualifies for a special license
- 10 plate under this section may apply to the veterans' affairs
- 11 commission for a veteran license sticker authorized under
- 12 W.S. 31-2-204(b) for each vehicle owned and registered
- 13 under the name of the veteran. Upon verification by the
- 14 Wyoming veterans' affairs commission that the veteran was
- 15 honorably discharged from service and specifying the
- 16 conflict service of the veteran and payment of the fee
- 17 established by the commission, the commission shall issue
- 18 the veteran license sticker for each vehicle for which the
- 19 veteran has paid the fee established by the commission.

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21 31-2-216. Special plates; former prisoners of war.

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- 23 (h) A veteran who qualifies for a special license
- 24 plate under this section may apply to the veterans' affairs

1 commission for a veteran license sticker authorized under

2 W.S 31-2-204(b) for each vehicle owned and registered under

3 the name of the veteran. Upon verification by the Wyoming

4 veterans' affairs commission that the veteran was honorably

5 discharged from service and specifying the conflict service

6 of the veteran and payment of the fee established by the

7 commission, the commission shall issue the veteran license

8 sticker for each vehicle for which the veteran has paid the

9 fee established by the commission.

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11 31-2-217. Special plates; Pearl Harbor survivors;

national quard members; purple heart recipients.

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14 (h) A veteran who qualifies for a special license plate under this section may apply to the veterans' affairs 15 16 commission for a veteran license sticker authorized under 17 W.S 31-2-204(b) for each vehicle owned and registered under the name of the veteran. Upon verification by the Wyoming 18 19 veterans' affairs commission that the veteran was honorably 20 discharged from service and specifying the conflict service 21 of the veteran and payment of the fee established by the 22 commission, the commission shall issue the veteran license 23 sticker for each vehicle for which the veteran has paid the

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fee established by the commission.
