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10	Section 1. W.S. 37-2-401 through 37-2-404 are created

14	CONSUMER ADVOCATE			
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37-2-401. Office of consumer advocate created; 1 2 purpose. 3 4 The office of consumer advocate is created as a separate 5 division within the public service commission. The office of consumer advocate shall represent the interests of 6 7 Wyoming citizens or broad classes of Wyoming citizens in matters involving public utilities. 8 9 10 37-2-402. Consumer advocate; powers and duties. 11 12 (a) The consumer advocate shall have the power to: 13 14 (i) Act as a consumer advocate in any matter within the jurisdiction of the commission; 15 16 17 (ii) Act as a party to a proceeding; 18 19 (iii) Appeal any decision of the commission 20 regardless of whether the consumer advocate appeared as a 21 party before the commission; 22

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(iv) Provide information and assistance to 1 2 individual consumers regarding proceedings within the 3 jurisdiction of the commission; 4 5 (v) Have the same access to books, maps, contracts, reports and records of every description as the 6 commission. 7 8 9 The consumer advocate shall not advocate for or (b) on behalf of any individual, organization or entity. 10 11 12 37-2-403. Consumer advocate; administrator and staff. 13 The administrative head of the division shall be an 14 administrator appointed by the governor not later than July 15 1, 2003. The administrator shall employ and supervise 16 17 personnel as authorized by legislative appropriation. Except as provided in W.S. 37-2-404 the employees of the 18 office of consumer advocate shall not be supervised or 19 20 directed by the commission. 21 22 37-2-404. Consumer advocate; funding and expenses. 23

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Funding for the office of consumer advocate shall be 1 2 included in the commission's budget and collected through 3 the uniform utility assessment. Incidental administrative 4 and clerical services for the office of consumer advocate 5 shall be provided by the commission. The commission shall decide all matters of shared administrative and clerical 6 7 personnel. 8 9 Section 2. W.S. 37-2-110(b) is repealed. 10 Section 3. 11 12 13 (a) Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) is appropriated from the special revenue fund under W.S. 14 37-2-106 to the public service commission to fund the 15 16 administrator's position, consulting assistance, travel expenses, computer facilities and office space for the 17 office of consumer advocate. 18 19 20 (b) Four (4) full-time positions are authorized for 21 the office of the consumer advocate. The administrator 22 shall employ two (2) rate analysts and one (1) attorney from personnel currently employed by the commission. 23 The 24 commission shall make a one (1) time designation of which

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existing positions may become full-time consumer advocate positions. Thereafter personnel within the office of consumer advocate shall be employed and supervised as provided by W.S. 37-2-403.
Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
