- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-12-301(b)(v), 37-12-302(a) and
- 8 (c) (intro) and 37-12-304(a), (b) (intro) and (i) are amended

13 (b) As used in this act:

- 15 (v) "Notification center" means a group of
- 16 persons having underground facilities who have jointly

established a "notification system" in a specific area to 1 permit notification by any person involved in excavation 2 3 activities center that receives notice from excavators of planned excavation or other requests for location and 4 5 transmits this notice to participating operators; 6 37-12-302. Notice 7 of excavation by excavator; information to be supplied upon notice; exceptions; 8 9 penalty. 10 11 (a) Every person having the right to bury underground facilities shall file with the county clerk in each county 12 13 where underground facilities are located notification 14 center a general description of the area served together with the name, address and telephone number of the person 15 in that county from whom necessary information may be 16 17 obtained concerning the location of underground facilities. within that county. In counties where a notification center 18 pursuant to W.S. 37-12-304 is established, the name, 19 20 address and telephone number of the notification center 21 shall be filed with the county clerk on behalf of all participating members. 22

1 (c) Except as hereafter provided, no person shall 2 make or begin excavation without first notifying any person having underground facilities in the area of the proposed 3 4 excavation. Notice shall be given by any electronic medium 5 or in person at least two (2) full business days, but not more than fourteen (14) business days prior to 6 7 excavation to all the notification centers existing within the area center pursuant to W.S. 37-12-304. Unless the 8 9 location marks are still visible, if an excavation on a single project lasts more than fourteen (14) business days, 10 11 the excavator shall give notice at least once each succeeding fourteen (14) business day period. Notice to the 12 13 notification center is notice to each member thereof in the 14 area. Notification of the following information to all the 15 notification centers in the area center shall be required 16 and shall include the:

(a) Persons having underground facilities shall join an existing the notification center of their choice or form a new notification center and shall participate in a the notification center providing for mutual receipt of notification of excavation activities in a specified area

- 7 (i) File with the county clerk the statewide
- 8 toll-free telephone number;, which shall be one (1) of the
- 9 two (2) authorized statewide toll-free numbers pursuant to
- 10 subsection (c) of this section, and description of the
- 11 geographical area served by the notification center. If
- 12 the geographical area served by the notification center is
- 13 not the entire state, the notification center shall
- 14 establish access for the center via an existing statewide
- 15 toll-free telephone number to be shared by notification
- 16 centers which serve limited geographic regions, and share
- 17 in the costs of that phone service;
