A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to railroads; authorizing the appointment
- 2 of railroad peace officers and specifying their
- 3 qualifications and authority; specifying responsibility for
- 4 liability arising from the acts or omissions of railroad
- 5 peace officers; limiting definitions; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-12-131 is created to read:

11

12 **37-12-131.** Railroad peace officers.

13

- 14 (a) A railroad company may appoint one (1) or more
- 15 persons to be designated by the railroad company as a
- 16 railroad peace officer for the protection of railroad

1 property and the protection of the persons and property of

2 railroad passengers and employees. While engaged in the

3 conduct of employment, each appointed railroad peace

4 officer may possess and exercise the powers of a peace

5 officer.

7 (b) The peace officer authority may be exercised only

8 in the protection of passengers and employees on or about

9 railroad premises and in the protection of property

10 belonging to passengers, or belonging to or under the

11 control of the railroad employing the railroad peace

12 officers, and in preventing, and making arrest for

13 violation of law upon the premises or in connection with

14 the property.

15

16 (c) A person appointed by a railroad company to act

17 as a railroad peace officer shall, prior to appointment,

18 meet the minimum qualifications established for peace

19 officers pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707.

20

21 (d) Before the appointee performs any duties as a

22 railroad peace officer, the railroad company shall file the

23 name of the appointee with the peace officer standards and

24 training commission. If the appointee meets minimum

- 1 qualifications for a peace officer, the director of the
- 2 commission shall issue to the appointee a certificate of
- 3 authority to act as a peace officer, to continue in effect
- 4 during his employment by the railroad unless revoked by the
- 5 peace officer standards and training commission for cause.

6

- 7 (e) A railroad company appointing a railroad peace
- 8 officer is responsible for any liability arising from the
- 9 acts or omissions of the railroad peace officer within the
- 10 scope of railroad employment, but is entitled to any
- 11 defense to liability that may be available to other peace
- 12 officers. Neither the state nor any of its political
- 13 subdivisions is liable for any act or omission of a
- 14 railroad peace officer.
