Medicaid-limit on services.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Medical Assistance and
2 Services Act; prohibiting the expansion of specified
3 federal waiver programs authorized by the legislature in
4 the 2001 general session; terminating the programs as
5 specified; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

10

11 (a) Effective immediately, the department of health
12 shall not accept or approve any applications for services
13 under:

14

15 (i) The adult acquired brain injury program
16 authorized by 2001 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 139,
17 Section 335 for not more than fifty (50) individuals;

2 (ii) The pilot project to reimburse assisted
3 living care services for not more than seventy-five (75)
4 individuals authorized by 2001 Wyoming Session Laws,
5 Chapter 184, Section 2(f).

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7 (b) Individuals receiving services in the programs
8 specified in subsection (a) of this section as of April 1,
9 2003, may continue to receive services, subject to
10 legislative appropriation.

11

12 (c) Upon termination of an individual's eligibility
13 for services in a program specified in subsection (a) of
14 this section, the department of health shall reduce its
15 funding for the appropriate program to the maximum number
16 of individuals specified in subsection (a) of this section.

17

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
21 Constitution.
