4	(b) Any driver of a motor vehicle who drives or
5	operates the vehicle in willful or wanton disregard of the
6	safety of persons or property while fleeing or eluding a
7	pursuing police vehicle is guilty of a felony.

9	(b)(c) Every Any person convicted of fleeing or
10	attempting to elude a police officer a violation of
11	subsection (a) of this section shall be punished by a fine
12	of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), $\frac{1}{2}$
13	by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or
14	both.

16	(d) Any person convicted of a violation of subsection
17	(b) of this section shall be fined not more than five
18	thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), imprisoned for not less than
19	one (1) year nor more than three (3) years, or both.

21	(e) Any person convicted of a violation of subsection
22	(b) or (c) of this section shall, in addition to the
23	penalties imposed by this section, have his driver's
24	license revoked pursuant to W.S. 31-7-127(a).

4	Except under circumstances constituting a violation of W.S.
5	<u>31-5-225(b), a</u> ny person who drives any vehicle in willful
6	or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property
7	is guilty of reckless driving.

9	31-7-127. Mandatory revocation of license for certain
10	violations.

12	(a) The division shall revoke the license or
13	nonresident operating privilege of any person, upon receipt
14	of a record of conviction of the person of any of the
15	following violations:

17	(viii) Conviction under W.S. 31-5-225(b) or (c).
