A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administrative procedure; modifying
2 filing requirements for state agency rules; making
3 conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-3-104(a) and 28-9-103(b) are
8 amended to read:

9

10 **16-3-104. Filing of copies of rules; permanent**
11 **register; effective dates; manner of preparation; advice**
12 **and assistance of attorney general.**

14 (a) Each agency shall file in the office of the
15 registrar of rules a certified copy of each rule adopted by
16 it as approved by the governor. State agencies shall file

1 each rule ~~within~~ not sooner than forty (40) days after
2 filing with the legislative service office pursuant to W.S.
3 28-9-103(b) and not later than sixty (60) days of the date
4 of agency action adopting the rule or it is not effective.
5 There shall be noted upon the rule a citation of the
6 authority by which it or any part of it was adopted. The
7 registrar of rules shall keep a permanent register of the
8 rules open to public inspection. Not more than ten (10)
9 days after a state agency files a copy of a rule in the
10 office of the registrar of rules, the agency shall mail a
11 notice that the rule has been filed to each person who was
12 sent a notice under W.S. 16-3-103(a)(i). The notice shall
13 contain a citation to the rule and the date it was filed.
14 Failure to send the notice required under this subsection
15 does not affect the effectiveness of the rule.

17 **28-9-103. Submission of rules for review; notice to**
18 **legislators.**

20 (b) An agency shall submit copies of adopted, amended
21 or repealed rules to the legislative service office for
22 review pursuant to W.S. 28-9-104 within ~~ten (10)~~ five (5)
23 days after the date of the agency's final action adopting,
24 amending or repealing those rules.

2 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
4 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
5 Constitution.
