The 6 7 registrar of rules shall keep a permanent register of the rules open to public inspection. Not more than ten (10) 8 9 days after a state agency files a copy of a rule in the 10 office of the registrar of rules, the agency shall mail a 11 notice that the rule has been filed to each person who was 12 sent a notice under W.S. 16-3-103(a)(i). The notice shall 13 contain a citation to the rule and the date it was filed. 14 Failure to send the notice required under this subsection does not affect the effectiveness of the rule. 15

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(b) An agency shall submit copies of adopted, amended or repealed rules to the legislative service office for review pursuant to W.S. 28-9-104 within ten (10) five (5) days after the date of the agency's final action adopting, amending or repealing those rules.

3	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
4	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
5	Constitution.
