## A BILL

## for

1	AN ACT relating to health insurance; providing for
2	prescription identification cards as specified; providing
3	requirements; providing for rules and regulations;
4	providing for applicability; and providing for an effective
5	date.

7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
8	
9	Section 1. W.S. 26-18-103(a) by creating new
10	paragraphs (x) and (xi) and 26-19-107 by creating new
11	subsections (m) and (n) are amended to read:
12	
13	26-18-103. General requirements for policies.
14	
15	(a) No disability insurance policy shall be delivered
16	or issued for delivery to any person in this state unless
17	it otherwise complies with this code and the following:

2	(x) If the policy provides coverage for
3	prescription drugs or devices, or administers such a plan,
4	the insurer shall issue to each insured a card or other
5	technology containing standardized pharmacy benefit
6	identification information. The card shall contain at a
7	minimum the following information:
8	
9	(A) The card issuer's name or logo
10	displayed on the front of the card;
11	
12	(B) The cardholder's name and
13	identification number displayed on the front of the card;
14	
15	(C) The American National Standards
16	Institute issuer identification number assigned to the
17	administrator or pharmacy benefit manager of the plan, if
18	required for proper claims adjudication;
19	
20	(D) The processor's control number, if
21	required for proper claims adjudication;
22	
23	(E) The insured's group number, if required
24	for proper claims adjudication;
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1	
2	(F) The name and address of the benefits
3	administrator or other entity responsible for prescription
4	claims submission, adjudication or pharmacy provider
5	correspondence for prescription benefits; and
6	
7	(G) A help desk telephone number that
8	pharmacy providers may call for pharmacy benefit claims
9	assistance.
10	
11	(xi) Paragraph (x) of this subsection shall not
12	require a health benefit plan insurer to issue an
13	identification card separate from any identification card
14	issued to an enrollee to evidence coverage under the health
15	benefit plan if the identification card contains the
16	elements required by paragraph (x) of this subsection. In
17	order to ensure that insurance identification cards issued
18	under paragraph (x) of this subsection contain accurate and
19	updated information, each health benefit plan insurer shall
20	provide each subscriber with a new insurance identification
21	card within a reasonable time after any information
22	required for proper claims adjudication is changed. The
23	commissioner may issue rules or regulations necessary to
24	implement the provisions of paragraph (x) of this

1	subsection and this paragraph in accordance with standards
2	produced by the National Council of Prescription Drugs
3	Programs.
4	
5	26-19-107. Group disability and blanket insurance
6	standard provisions; exceptions.
7	
8	(m) An insurer of a policy of group disability or
9	blanket disability which provides coverage for prescription
10	drugs or devices, or that administers such a plan, shall
11	issue to each insured a card or other technology containing
12	standardized pharmacy benefit identification information.
13	The card shall contain at a minimum the following
14	information:
15	
16	(i) The card issuer's name or logo displayed on
17	the front of the card;
18	
19	(ii) The cardholder's name and identification
20	number displayed on the front of the card;
21	
22	(iii) The American National Standards Institute
23	issuer identification number assigned to the administrator

1	or pharmacy benefit manager of the plan if required for
2	proper claims adjudication;
3	
4	(iv) The processor's control number, if required
5	for proper claims adjudication;
6	
7	(v) The insured's group number, if required for
8	proper claims adjudication;
9	
10	(vi) The name and address of the benefits
11	administrator or other entity responsible for prescription
12	claims submission, adjudication or pharmacy provider
13	correspondence for prescription benefits; and
14	
15	(vii) A help desk telephone number that pharmacy
16	providers may call for pharmacy benefit claims assistance.
17	
18	(n) Subsection (m) of this section shall not require
19	a health benefit plan to issue an identification card
20	separate from any identification card issued to an enrollee
21	to evidence coverage under the health benefit plan if the
22	identification card contains the elements required by
23	subsection (m) of this section. In order to ensure that
24	insurance identification cards issued under subsection (m)

1	of this section contain accurate and updated information,
2	each health benefit plan insurer shall provide each
3	subscriber with a new insurance identification card within
4	a reasonable time after any information required for proper
5	claims adjudication is changed. The commissioner may issue
6	rules or regulations necessary to implement the provisions
7	of subsection (m) of this section and this subsection in
8	accordance with standards produced by the National Council
9	of Prescription Drugs Programs.
10	
11	Section 2. This act shall apply to any disability
12	insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery or renewed
13	on or after the effective date of this act.
14	
15	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
