4 use tax within all national parks within Wyoming; providing

5 that the game and fish commission will manage wolves and

6 grizzly bears as specified; and providing for an effective

7 date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-304 is created to read:

14 created; revenues deposited; appropriations; payments from

- 1 (a) There is created the wolf and grizzly bear
- 2 management account within the earmarked revenue fund. All
- 3 funds collected pursuant to W.S. 39-15-104(g) and
- 4 39-16-104(f) shall be deposited into the account by the
- 5 state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of W.S.
- 6 39-15-111(p) and 39-16-111(p). Once deposited, interest
- 7 earned by the account shall be retained in the account.

- 9 (b) Funds in the account are continuously
- 10 appropriated for use and expenditure by the commission for
- 11 the costs of administering the duties stated in W.S.
- 12 23-1-302(a)(xxix) and paying for damages pursuant to W.S.
