A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; establishing the animal euthanasia certification board as 2 3 specified; authorizing the board to certify animal euthanasia technicians; specifying eligibility criteria; 4 5 specifying approved training and testing; prohibiting persons from acting as an animal euthanasia technician 6 7 without certification; granting rulemaking authority; providing definitions; providing penalties; providing for 8 9 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 12

13 Section 1. W.S. 33-30-216 through 33-30-222 are 14 created to read:

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16 **33-30-216**. **Definitions**.

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1 2 (a) As used in this act: 3 4 (i) "Board" means the Wyoming animal euthanasia 5 technician certification board; 6 7 (ii) "Certified animal euthanasia technician" means a person who is employed or sponsored by a law 8 9 enforcement agency whose duties include euthanizing 10 unwanted, sick, injured or dangerous animals; 11 12 (iii) "Euthanasia" or "euthanizing" means the 13 act or practice of providing a humane death for animals 14 through the use of euthanizing drugs; 15 (iv) "Euthanizing drugs" means 16 any pentobarbital-based drug labeled by the manufacturer for 17 the purpose of euthanizing animals; 18 19 20 (v) "This act" means W.S. 33-30-216 through 21 33-30-222. 22 33-30-217. Animal euthanasia technician certification 23 board created; composition; terms of office. 24

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2 There is created the animal euthanasia technician (a) 3 certification board. The board shall consist of five (5) 4 members appointed by the governor. Initial board members 5 shall be appointed upon the recommendation of the Wyoming state board of veterinary medicine. Thereafter, the animal 6 euthanasia technician certification board shall make 7 recommendations to the governor after receiving the 8 9 recommendation of the Wyoming state board of veterinary medicine. 10

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The initial membership of the board shall include 12 (b) 13 at least one (1) licensed veterinarian, one (1) actively 14 employed animal control officer, one (1) law enforcement official whose duties include supervision of animal control 15 16 and one (1) citizen from the public at large. Thereafter, 17 members of the board shall be certified euthanasia technicians, veterinarians licensed in this state or 18 19 certified peace officers.

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(c) Members of the board shall serve terms of three
(3) years. The initial board shall have staggered terms of
one (1) member for one (1) year, two (2) members for two
(2) years and two (2) members for three (3) years.

Duties and powers of board. 3 (a) The board shall: 4 5 (i) Grant, suspend or revoke the certification of 6 any animal euthanasia technician. The board shall examine 7 the credentials of applicants for certification and current 8 9 certificate holders and may grant, suspend or revoke 10 certification on the basis of the credentials or upon other cause as specified by the rules of the board. In addition, 11 12 the board may require oral interviews and practical 13 demonstrations; 14 15 (ii) Examine and approve available animal euthanasia training and testing programs for use by 16 17 applicants for certification. In the absence of available animal euthanasia training and testing programs, the board 18 19 shall develop a program for use by animal euthanasia 20 technicians in this state. A program approved or developed 21 pursuant to this paragraph shall include: 22 23 (A) Methods of humanely euthanizing 24 injured, sick, homeless or unwanted animals;

2003 STATE OF WYOMING 03LSO-0465 1 2 (B) Security precautions; 3 4 (C) Record keeping; and 5 (D) Other skills as determined necessary by 6 7 the board. 8 9 (iii) Promulgate rules and regulations in 10 accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act 11 necessary for the implementation of this act, including the 12 establishment of fees provided for by this act and rules 13 relating to professional conduct which establish ethical 14 and professional standards of practice; 15 16 (iv) Conduct investigations and hearings pursuant 17 to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act. 18 19 33-30-219. Certified animal euthanasia technicians; 20 eligibility; surrender or revocation of certificate; fees; 21 other requirements. 22 (a) Any person applying for a certification as an 23 24 animal euthanasia technician shall be employed or sponsored 5

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1	by a law enforcement agency. An applicant shall make a
2	written application to the board which shall include:
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4	(i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to
5	rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars
6	(\$100.00);

8	(ii) Proof that the applicant:

10	(A) Is of good moral character;
11	
12	(B) Is a citizen of the United States or is
13	lawfully admitted to remain and work in the United States;

15	(C) Is employed or sponsored by a law
16	enforcement agency;

18	(D) Has not been convicted of a felony or
19	any criminal violation relating to cruelty to animals or
20	animal neglect; and

22	(E) Has completed an animal euthanasia
23	training and testing program approved or developed by the
24	board.

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1 2 (iii) Proof that the employing sponsoring agency 3 has obtained any required federal permits; 4 5 (iv) A criminal history background check required pursuant to W.S. 7-19-106(a)(x); 6 7 (v) Any other information required by the board. 8 9 10 (b) A certification issued pursuant to this section 11 shall be for a two (2) year period unless surrendered by 12 the certified animal euthanasia technician or revoked or suspended by the board for cause. The certified animal 13 euthanasia technician shall renew the certificate every two 14 (2) years. Application for renewal shall be accompanied 15 16 by: 17 (i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to 18 rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars 19 20 (\$100.00); 21 (ii) Proof of current employment or sponsorship 22 by a law enforcement agency; and 23 24

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1 (iii) Proof of a minimum of eight (8) hours of 2 board approved training during the previous two (2) year 3 period.

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5 (c) The fees received under subsection (a) or (b) of 6 this section shall be deposited with the state treasurer 7 who shall credit the money to an account within the special 8 revenue fund. All monies credited to the account shall be 9 expended only upon appropriation by the legislature to 10 defray costs and expenses incurred in the administration of 11 this act.

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13 (d) In addition to other requirements of this act, a 14 certified animal euthanasia technician shall register with 15 the Wyoming board of pharmacy to purchase, possess and 16 administer euthanizing drugs.

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20 Board members shall receive no compensation for their 21 services but shall receive per diem and travel expenses in 22 the manner and amount provided for state employees by W.S. 23 9-3-102 and 9-3-103.

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3	Any person employed or sponsored by a law enforcement
4	agency who euthanizes an animal without being certified
5	according to the provisions of this act is guilty of a
6	misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more that seven
7	hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), imprisonment for not more
8	than six (6) months or both.
