1 AN ACT relating to schools; regulating beverages offered to
2 students in schools; providing enforcement; and providing
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-4-601 is created to read:

12 **21-4-601. Student nutrition; beverages.**

14 (a) The only beverages that shall be offered for sale
15 on school property to elementary, middle school and high
16 school students are as follows:

1

2 (i) Water;

3

4 (ii) Milk, including chocolate milk, soy milk,
5 rice milk and other similar dairy or nondairy milk; and

6

7 (iii) One hundred percent (100%) fruit juices,
8 or fruit-based drinks that are composed of no less than
9 fifty percent (50%) fruit juice and that have no added
10 sweeteners.

11

12 (b) The restriction on beverages offered for sale to
13 students applies from one-half (1/2) hour before the start
14 of the school day until one-half (1/2) hour after the end
15 of the school day.

16

17 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-2-202(a) by creating a new
18 paragraph (xxiii) is amended to read:

19

20 **21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.**

21

22 (a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
23 the state superintendent shall:

24

1 (xxiii) Promote student health in school,
2 including nutritional health through department staff and
3 programs, and enforce district compliance with W.S.
4 21-4-601 regulating beverages offered to students.

5

6 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
