- 14 (a) No disability insurance policy shall be delivered
- 15 or issued for delivery to any person in this state unless
- 16 it otherwise complies with this code and the following:

2 (x) If issued or delivered on or after July 1, 3 2003, and the policy provides benefits or coverage for 4 prescription drugs or devices, the policy shall include 5 benefits or coverage for any prescription contraceptive drug or device approved by the federal Food and Drug 6 7 Administration under the same terms and conditions as the policy provides for other prescription drugs or devices; 8 9 10 (xi) If issued or delivered on or after July 1, 11 2003, and the policy provides benefits or coverage for 12 outpatient services provided by a health care professional, 13 the policy shall include benefits or coverage for 14 outpatient contraceptive services under the same terms and conditions as the policy provides for other prescription 15 16 drugs or devices. 17 18 26-19-107. 13 (n) All group and blanket disability insurance 14 policies providing coverage on an expense incurred basis, 15 group service or indemnity type contracts issued by a nonprofit corporation, group service contracts issued by a 16 17 health maintenance organization, all self-insured group 18 arrangements to the extent not preempted by federal law and 19 all managed health care delivery entities of any type or 20 description, that are delivered, issued for delivery, 21 continued or renewed on or after July 1, 2003, and 22 providing benefits or coverage to any resident of this 23 state for outpatient services provided by a health care 24 professional shall include benefits or coverage for any
