A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to off-road recreational vehicles;
2 modifying requirements for applying for decals; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-702(b) is amended to read:

9 **31-2-702. Registration selling agents; application**
10 **for trail user registration decal; affidavit required if**
11 **vehicle serial number not visible; penalty.**

13 (b) Beginning January 1, 2002, each owner of an off-
14 road recreational vehicle shall for each vehicle used on
15 Wyoming off-road recreational vehicle trails as established

1 and administered by the department, annually file in
2 writing and in duplicate with any designated registration
3 selling agent, an application for trail user registration
4 of the off-road recreational vehicle. The application shall
5 state the name and address of the owner, the name of the
6 applicant and the make, model and identifying serial number
7 of the off-road recreational vehicle. If the vehicle
8 identifying serial number is not legible or visible, the
9 applicant shall upon a form provided by the department,
10 provide proof of ownership by affidavit certified in
11 writing. At the time of application, the applicant shall
12 also present proof in a form approved by the department of
13 revenue that all sales or use tax due on the off-road
14 recreational vehicle have been paid. Any person knowingly
15 presenting a false or fraudulent statement under this
16 subsection is subject to the penalties provided by W.S.
17 6-5-303 in addition to possible penalties and interest due
18 for nonpayment of sales or use tax on the off-road
19 recreational vehicle.

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
