- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-233 (h) (i) and by creating a new
- 8 paragraph (iv) is amended to read:

- 10 31-5-233. Driving or having control of vehicle while
- 11 under influence of intoxicating liquor or controlled
- 12 substances; penalties.

- 14 (h) As used in this subsection, "serious bodily
- 15 injury" means bodily injury which creates a reasonable
- 16 likelihood of death or which causes miscarriage or serious
- 17 permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of

1 any bodily member or organ. Whoever causes serious bodily 2 injury to another person resulting from the violation of this section shall be punished upon conviction as follows: 3 4 5 (i) If not subject to the penalty penalties 6 under paragraph paragraphs (ii) and (iv) of 7 subsection, by a fine of not less than two thousand dollars five thousand dollars 8 (\$2,000.00) nor more than 9 (\$5,000.00), imprisonment for not less than six (6) months 10 nor more than one (1) year, or both; 11 12 (iv) If not subject to the penalty under 13 paragraph (ii) of this section and serious bodily injury 14 occurs, resulting in the permanent loss of one (1) or more 15 arms or legs or blindness, by a fine of not less than three 16 thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) nor more than five thousand 17 dollars (\$5,000.00), imprisonment for not less than one (1) 18 year nor more than three (3) years, or both. 19 20 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
