- 1 AN ACT relating to minerals; requiring documents related to 2 mineral exploration be reported to the Wyoming geological
- 3 survey board as specified; providing for the collection and
- 4 confidentiality of documents as specified; providing
- 5 penalties for violations of reporting requirements;
- 6 specifying application; and providing for an effective
- 7 date.

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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-807(e) by creating a new
- 12 paragraph (iii), 16-4-203(d) by creating a new paragraph
- 13 (xiii) and 35-11-404 by creating new subsections (o) and
- 14 (p) are amended to read:

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9-2-807. Geological survey board; 1 created; 2 membership; term; qualifications; removal; vacancies; 3 election of officers; meetings; quorum; compensation; 4 expenses; duties. 5 6 (e) The board shall: 7 (iii) Collect and preserve all logs, surveys, 8 9 assays and other documents filed under W.S. 35-11-404(o). 10 All documents filed under this paragraph shall be held confidential for a period of three (3) years after initial 11 12 receipt by the state geologist and confidentiality may be extended in one (1) year increments upon receipt by the 13 14 state geologist of a written request by certified mail, 15 return receipt requested, from the person or legal entity 16 who filed the documents requesting that confidentiality be 17 extended. All requests must be received prior to December 31 of the year following expiration of the period of 18 19 confidentiality. All logs, surveys, assays and other documents shall become the property of the state to be 20 21 retained within the permanent files of the Wyoming 22 geological survey board for the use of the staff and public 23 after the period of confidentiality has expired.

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16-4-203. Right of inspection; grounds for denial; 1 2 access of news media; order permitting or restricting 3 disclosure; exception. 4 5 (d) The custodian shall deny the right of inspection of the following records, unless otherwise provided by law: 6 7 (xiii) Documents filed with the geological 8 9 survey board at the office of the state geologist subject 10 to the provisions of W.S. 9-2-807(e)(iii). 11 35-11-404. Drill 12 holes to be capped, sealed 13 plugged; mineral exploration reporting requirements. 14 15 (o) A person who has sunk a drill hole pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall file with the 16 geological survey board at the office of the state 17 18 geologist all logs, surveys, assays or other factual 19 documents relating to exploration within ninety (90) days 20 from the date the exploration is completed. The 21 requirements of this subsection shall not apply to drilling done pursuant to an active mine permit filed with the 22 23 Wyoming department of environmental quality.

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1	(p) In addition to the penalties in subsection (k) of
2	this section, the administrator of the land quality
3	division may recommend to the director that a person who
4	violates the provisions of subsection (o) of this section
5	or who willfully and knowingly authorizes, orders or
6	carries out a violation of subsection (o) of this section
7	be denied any request for a drilling, exploration or mining
8	permit until all documents required to be filed under
9	subsection (o) of this section have been filed.
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11	Section 2. This act shall not apply retroactively to
12	require filing logs, surveys, assays or other documents
13	relating to exploration commenced on or before the
14	effective date of this act.
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16	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
