Drivers inclusion act.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to driver's licenses; modifying application
2 requirements for driver's licenses; modifying the
3 information required on driver's licenses; repealing
4 driver's license prohibition; and providing for an
5 effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-111(a) and by creating a new
10 subsection (g) and 31-7-115(a)(iii)(C) are amended to read:

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12 **31-7-111. Application for license or permit**
13 **generally.**

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15 (a) Every application for instruction permit,
16 driver's license, commercial driver's license or commercial

1 driver instruction permit shall be made upon a form
2 furnished by the division. Every application shall be
3 accompanied by the proper fee. ~~and, if the~~ Except for an
4 applicant who is not a citizen of the United States, every
5 applicant who has not previously been licensed in this
6 state or another jurisdiction, shall submit a certified
7 copy of the applicant's birth certificate with his
8 application. If the applicant is not a citizen of the
9 United States, additional documentation is required
10 pursuant to subsection (g).

12 (g) An applicant who is not a citizen of the United
13 States shall provide two (2) documents of identification,
14 as follows:

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16 (i) Any one (1) of the following documents:

17
18 (A) High security matricula issued by the
19 Mexican government;

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21 (B) An individual tax identification number
22 issued by the Internal Revenue Service;

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1 (C) An alien registration receipt card,
2 resident alien card or other authorized document issued by
3 a federal governmental agency other than the Immigration
4 and Naturalization Service;

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6 (D) An employment authorization card or
7 temporary resident card;

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9 (E) A passport, a federal identification
10 card or other verifiable certificate or document issued by
11 a federal governmental agency other than the Immigration
12 Naturalization Service; and

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14 (ii) Any one (1) of the following documents:

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16 (A) Military papers issued by the defense
17 department of a foreign country;

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19 (B) Any type of generally recognized
20 governmental registration document issued by a governmental
21 agency of a foreign country;

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23 (C) Voter identification card issued by a
24 governmental agency of a foreign country;

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(D) A duplicate original birth certificate or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by this or another state or by another country, if accompanied by supportive documentation required by department rule;

(E) Any other certificate or document issued by the government of a foreign country or business entity located in a foreign country, if the certificate or document includes a photo of the person to whom the certificate or document has been issued;

(F) Any other proof of identity satisfactory to the department.

31-7-115. Issuance, description and contents.

(a) Upon the satisfactory completion of any required examination, the division shall issue to every qualifying applicant a driver's license, and:

(iii) The driver's license shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:

1 (C) The full legal name, any identifying
2 numbers or letters deemed appropriate, date of birth,
3 mailing address, height, weight and sex of the licensee.
4 Unless otherwise required by federal law, neither the
5 social security number nor temporary identification number
6 issued by the Internal Revenue Service, of the person shall
7 not be required on a driver's license. The division shall
8 provide on the application form required by W.S.
9 31-7-111(a) an option for the applicant to include his
10 social security number or temporary identification number
11 on his driver's license;

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13 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-7-108(b)(vi) is repealed.

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15 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
