2	numbers or letters deemed appropriate, date of birth,
3	mailing address, height, weight and sex of the licensee.
4	Unless otherwise required by federal law, <u>neither</u> the
5	social security number <u>nor temporary identification number</u>
6	issued by the Internal Revenue Service, of the person shall
7	not be required on a driver's license. The division shall
8	provide on the application form required by W.S.
9	31-7-111(a) an option for the applicant to include his
10	social security number or temporary identification number
11	on his driver's license;
