5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-524 (a) (intro), (i) and (b) (i) is
- 8 amended to read:

10 18-3-524. Appointments to fill vacancies; term.

- 12 (a) Within  $\frac{\text{thirty}}{\text{thenty}}$  (30) twenty (20) days after the
- 13 office of any county commissioner becomes vacant the
- 14 remaining members of the board shall declare a vacancy to
- 15 exist and immediately give notice of the vacancy in writing
- 16 to the chairman of the county central committee of the

1 political party to which the member whose office is vacant

2 belonged. The chairman of the county central committee

3 shall within  $\frac{\text{ten}}{\text{ten}}$  (10) twenty (20) days after receipt of the

4 notice call a meeting of the county central committee. At

5 the meeting the committee shall select three (3) persons

6 qualified to fill the vacancy and transmit the names to the

7 board of county commissioners. The board of county

8 commissioners shall fill the vacancy within thirty (30)

9 twenty (20) days after receiving the list from the county

10 central committee by appointing one (1) of the persons

11 whose names are submitted by the county central committee:

13 (i) If the county central committee fails to

14 select and transmit the list of three (3) names to the

15 board of county commissioners within  $\frac{\text{ten}}{\text{(10)}}$   $\frac{\text{twenty}}{\text{twenty}}$ 

16 days, the board shall fill the vacancy by the appointment

17 of any qualified person belonging to the same political

18 party as the incumbent commissioner;

20 (b) If the remaining members of the board of county

21 commissioners fail to fill any vacancy in a board of county

22 commissioners within the time specified in this section,

23 any qualified elector of the county may file a petition

24 with the clerk of the district court of the county in which

1 the vacancy occurred requesting the judge of the district

2 court to fill the vacancy:

3

4 (i) Within thirty (30)—twenty (20) days after

5 the petition is filed the judge shall fill the vacancy by

6 appointing a qualified elector of the county belonging to

7 the same political party as the incumbent commissioner. If

8 the incumbent commissioner did not belong to any political

9 party the judge may appoint any qualified person to fill

10 the vacancy.

12 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
