- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-1-101(a) (viii) by creating a new
- 9 subparagraph (H) and by creating a new paragraph (xxvi),
- 10 12-4-506(a), (b), (d)(iii), (vi), (viii), by creating a new
- 11 paragraph (ix), by renumbering (ix) as (x) and (e) are
- 12 amended to read:

14 **12-1-101**. **Definitions**.

16 (a) As used in this title:

1 2 (viii) "Licensee" means a person holding a: 3 4 (H) Special event liquor permit. 5 (xxvi) "Special event" means an event sponsored 6 7 by any of the following organizations: 8 9 (A) A nonprofit organization owning or 10 leasing facilities for the purpose of a rodeo or similar 11 event that is recognized and sanctioned by a national 12 professional rodeo association; 13 14 (B) A nonprofit organization owning or 15 leasing facilities to operate a museum or historical 16 center. 17 18 12-4-506. Special event liquor permit for Wyoming 19 territorial prison state park and historical site, 20 nonprofit organizations owning or leasing facilities for 21 rodeos, museums, concerts and special events authorized by local authorities. 2.2

1	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title
2	and subject to subsection (d) of this section, the
3	appropriate licensing authority may upon application, issue
4	a special event liquor permit for the sale of alcoholic
5	liquor and malt beverages to the board of directors of the
6	management group for the Wyoming territorial prison state
7	park and historical site as authorized under this
8	<u>subsection</u> . Restrictions imposed under the retail liquor
9	license population formula pursuant to W.S. 12-4-201 shall
10	not apply to the a special event liquor permit issued under
11	this <u>section</u> <u>subsection</u> . <u>The special event liquor permit</u>
12	may be issued by the appropriate licensing authority:

14	(i) To the board of directors of the management
15	group for the Wyoming territorial prison state park and

18	(ii) To the board of directors or trustees of
19	the management group of a facility sponsoring a special
20	event within the premises owned or leased by the management

24	event liquor permit issued pursuant to subsection (a) of

- 1 this section shall not sell—authorize the sale of alcoholic
- 2 liquor and malt beverages under the special event liquor
- 3 permit for consumption off the premises owned or leased by
- 4 the management group permittee.

- The local licensing authority issuing the permit 6
- 7 shall by rule and regulation establish the following
- conditions and limitations for the special event liquor 8
- 9 permit issued under this section which, to the extent
- 10 applicable, are not less stringent than relevant
- 11 requirements and provisions of this title:

- 13 (iii) The location of areas where alcoholic
- 14 liquor and malt beverages may be consumed on the premises
- owned or leased by the management group permittee; 15

- 17 (vi) With the exception of the Horse
- Theatre located within the Wyoming territorial prison state 18
- 19 park and historical site, liquor alcoholic liquors and malt
- 20 beverages shall not be served as part of the Wyoming
- 21 territorial prison state park and historical site's
- 22 permittee's daily operations or venues;

1 (viii) If alcoholic liquor is and malt beverages 2 are being served for a catered or sponsored special event 3 during the permittee's normal operating hours, of the 4 Wyoming territorial prison state park and historical site, 5 the site, area or property where the alcoholic liquor is and malt beverages are being served shall be restricted 6 7 from the general public and the perimeter of the event secured so that liquor is not carried into other areas or 8 9 properties of the park permittee where members of the 10 general public who are not participating in the catered or 11 special event are present; 12 13 (ix) Only malt beverages may be served and 14 consumed at locations open to the general public on 15 premises owned or leased by the permittee and authorized by 16 the appropriate licensing authority, except that alcoholic 17 liquors may be given free to the general public by licensed industry representatives as defined by W.S. 12-1-101(a)(vi) 18 19 as samples at designated areas approved by the local 20 licensing authority. 21 22 $\frac{(ix)}{(x)}$ Other rules and regulations the 23 licensing authority determines necessary to carry out this

2 (e) As used in this section "management group" means 3 the local public or private nonprofit entity serving as the

4 single management group of the Wyoming territorial prison

5 state park and historical site pursuant to W.S.

6 36-8-1002(b)(i) or a nonprofit organization owning or

7 leasing facilities for the purpose of a rodeo or similar

8 event that is recognized and sanctioned by a national

9 professional rodeo association.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

14 Constitution.
