5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-20-112 is created to read:

- 9 1-20-112. Exemption for crime victim awards,
- 10 insurance payments and tort litigation payments.

- 12 (a) The following are exempt from execution,
- 13 attachment, garnishment or any other process issued by any
- 14 court:

- 16 (i) An award pursuant to W.S. 1-40-103 or other
- 17 crime victims' reparation law;

2 (ii) A payment resulting from the wrongful death

3 of an individual of whom the debtor was a dependent,

4 reasonably necessary for the support of the debtor or a

5 dependent of the debtor;

7 (iii) A payment pursuant to a life insurance

8 contract that insured the life of an individual of whom the

9 debtor was a dependent on the date of the individual's

10 death, reasonably necessary for the support of the debtor

11 or a dependent of the debtor;

13 (iv) A payment, not to exceed twenty-five

14 thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) and excluding punitive

15 damages, resulting from a personal bodily injury to the

16 debtor or a dependent of the debtor;

18 (v) A payment in compensation for loss of past

19 or future earning of the debtor or an individual of whom

20 the debtor is, or was, a dependent, reasonably necessary

21 for the support of the debtor or a dependent of the debtor.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
