(a) As used in W.S. 6-1-101 through 6-10-203 unless 1 2 otherwise defined: 3 (vi) "Peace officer" includes the following 4 5 officers assigned to duty in the state of Wyoming: 6 7 (J) Any duly authorized detention officer who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707, 8 9 when engaged in the performance of his duties while supervising a detainee who has been convicted as a felon; 10 11 and 12 13 (M) Any peace officer certified by another state who has been appointed as a special deputy sheriff of 14 a Wyoming county pursuant to W.S. 18-3-602(c); and 15 16 17 (N) Any superintendent, assistant 18 superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park 19 or historic site who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 20 through 9-1-707, when acting within the boundaries of the 21 state park or historic site, or when responding to a

(xxiv) "Law enforcement officer" means 5 sheriff, undersheriff or sheriff's deputy of any county of 6 7 this state, any duly authorized municipal policeman of any city or town of this state, any member of the Wyoming 8 9 highway patrol, any police officer of the University of Wyoming or any Wyoming community college who is a peace 10 11 officer, or any special agent employed by the commissioner 12 or any superintendent, assistant under this act 13 superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park 14 or historic site who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 15 through 9-1-707, when acting within the boundaries of the 16 state park or historic site, or when responding to a 17 request to assist other peace officers performing their 18 official duties;
