A BILL

for 1 AN ACT relating to public school driver's education 2 programs; providing reimbursement to school districts for program costs; requiring the department of education to 3 establish program guidelines and reimbursement procedures; 4 providing for audits by the department of audit; providing 5 6 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 21-3-501 is created to read: 10 11

12 ARTICLE 5

13 DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAMS

15 21-3-501. Driver's education programs.

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(a) Any school district providing instruction in 1 2 grades nine (9) through twelve (12) for driver's education 3 shall upon application to the department of education in 4 accordance with subsection (b) of this section, 5 reimbursed an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the amount actually expended by the district during 6 7 immediately preceding school year for driver's education programs. Reimbursement under this section shall be paid 8 9 by the department to the qualifying district on or before 10 October 15 of any school year.

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12 (b) Application under subsection (a) of this section 13 shall be in a manner and form prescribed by department rule and regulation, shall include driver's education program 14 expenditures for the applicable reporting period and shall 15 16 be submitted to the department not later than September 1 17 of the appropriate school year. Expenditures qualifying for reimbursement under this section shall be subject to 18 guidelines and standards established by department rule and 19 20 regulation.

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22 (c) The school finance section of the department of 23 audit established under W.S. 9-1-513 shall conduct periodic 24 audits of the information submitted within applications

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1 filed under this section and shall include the resulting

2 audit findings within the department's annual report to the

3 legislature required by W.S. 9-1-513(b)(viii).

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5 **Section 2.** Six hundred fifty thousand dollars 6 (\$650,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the

7 state department of education to implement this act during

8 school year 2003-2004. To the extent amounts appropriated

9 under this section are not sufficient to reimburse

10 districts the amounts authorized under W.S. 21-3-501 as

11 created under section 1 of this act, the department shall

12 determine a uniform percentage by which reimbursements to

13 districts are reduced so that available revenues for school

14 year 2003-2004 are as nearly as possible equal to the

amount authorized under W.S. 21-3-501.

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17 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
