- 11 (a) In celebration of the end of slavery in the
- 12 United States proclaimed by Major General Gordon Granger on
- 13 June 19, 1865 more than two and one-half (2½) years after
- 14 the Emancipation Proclamation was issued by President
- 15 Abraham Lincoln, and in recognition of those who died and
- 16 sacrificed to achieve the end of slavery, the Juneteenth
- 17 holiday is established.

2 (b) The Juneteenth holiday shall be celebrated each

By ear with appropriate activities on the third Saturday of

4 June.

6 (c) This section shall not affect commercial paper,

7 the making or execution of written agreements or judicial

8 proceedings, or authorize public schools, business or state
