A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle insurance; requiring
2 insurers to report information under certain circumstances;
3 providing a penalty; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-8-204 is created to read:

8

9 **31-8-204. Information required from insurers;**
10 **penalty.**

11

12 (a) An insurer issuing an insurance policy required
13 by W.S. 31-4-103 or 31-9-401 through 31-9-414 shall send a
14 monthly list, within ten (10) days after the month has
15 ended, of persons insured to the department of
16 transportation and of persons whose policies have lapsed

1 have terminated or cancelled the insurance during the
2 relevant month.

4 (b) An insurer willfully failing to comply with the
5 requirements of subsection (c) of this section is guilty of
6 a misdemeanor and upon conviction is subject to a fine of
7 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00).

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9 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-8-203 is amended to read:

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11 **31-8-203. Verification of insurance; enforcement by**
12 **insurance commissioner.**

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14 (a) If the department has reason to believe a vehicle
15 owner is not insured as required under W.S. 31-4-103, it
16 may request an insurer to verify the existence of an
17 automobile liability policy in a form approved by the
18 department not later than twenty (20) days from the date
19 the request is made. ~~W.S. 31-8-201 through 31-8-203 shall~~
20 ~~not be construed to require an insurer to report at any~~
21 ~~time other than upon the specific request of the department~~
22 ~~for information.~~

1 (b) The insurance commissioner may order insurers to
2 comply with W.S. 31-8-201 and 31-8-204, rules and
3 regulations promulgated by the department under W.S.
4 31-8-201 and 31-8-204 and this section.

5

6 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
