## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to medical assistance and services; 2 providing for increased reimbursement for obstetric services under the Wyoming Medical Assistance and Services 3 Act for a specified period; repealing a subsidy provision 4 for obstetric services under the act; deappropriating 5 6 funds; making appropriations; specifying application; requiring a report; and providing for an effective date. 7 8 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10 11 Section 1. For the period commencing July 1, 2004 and 12 ending June 30, 2006, services authorized under the Wyoming Medical Assistance and Services Act involving the delivery 13 of a child, including prenatal and postpartum care related 14 15 to the delivery, shall be reimbursed at one hundred percent 16 (100%) of the provider's usual and customary billed charges. This reimbursement rate shall apply if the service 17

was rendered during the period commencing July 1, 2004 and 1 2 ending June 30, 2006. 3 4 Section 2. 2004 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 101, 5 Section 2 is amended to read: 6 7 Section 2. There is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for the 8 9 purposes of this act three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000.00) of which two 10 11 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) is 12 reserved for the purchase of tail coverage and 13 which shall remain available for expenditure until June 30, 2006. 14 15 Section 3. 2004 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 101, 16 17 Section 1(a) through (c) is repealed. 18 19 Section 4. The department of health shall report to 20 the joint appropriations interim committee on or before 21 October 31, 2005, the additional costs incurred by the 22 increased reimbursement rate under this act and recommendations for modifications to the reimbursement rate 23

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for obstetric services under the Medical Assistance and 1 2 Services Act. 3 Section 5. 4 5 6 million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) (a) Three 7 appropriated to the department of health under 2004 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 101, Section 2 is deappropriated and 8 9 shall be deposited in the general fund. 10 11 (b) For purposes of this act there is appropriated to 12 the department of health for the period commencing July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2006: 13 14 15 (i) Two million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$2,800,000.00) from the general fund; and 16 17 18 Three million five hundred thousand dollars (ii) (\$3,500,000.00) in federal funds. 19 20
